

Design the perfect flower for bees

Use paper plates, pipe cleaners, beads, sequins and other decorative materials to create your own 'perfect flower'.

You could:

- Cut the edges of the paper plate into different shaped petals
- Fold it to form a cup shape
- Stick coloured paper petals of different shapes around the edge.
- Make stamens for the centre
- ➤ What will the shape of the petals be?
- How many petals will there be?
- ➤ Will the centre of the flower be 'flat' or shaped like a 'trumpet' or a 'vessel'?
- > How long will the stamens and stigma be?
- ➤ Will the petals and the pollen rub against the bee as it goes into the flower?
- ➤ Will the flower have any markings to attract the bee into the centre?
- What colour/ will your flower be?
